

TEFAP/CSFP Income Guidelines
October 1, 2019 – September 30, 2020

Wyoming households are eligible to receive commodities at participating food pantries if the total gross income for the household does not exceed 130% of the federal poverty level. Eligibility is based on self-declared income. There are no income eligibility criteria for persons who voluntarily seek meals at soup kitchens or homeless shelters.
